November Car Run to the Greenfields Wetlands

A warm 33 degrees was forecast when we gathered at the clubrooms for the run to the Salisbury Council's Greenfields Wetlands. The Morris Car Club were also gathering there for their run.

We set off via Glenelg North and West Lakes to the Jervois Bridge, the Birkenhead Bridge and the newer Diver Dan Bridge. We could see that another boat was tied up next to the "One and All" so we made a quick detour to No. 2 Dock to see what it was. It turned out to be the "Young Endeavour", looking all shipshape in the sun. Roadworks on the Port River Expressway slowed us down for a short time but we were soon at the Wetlands.

"Greenfields Wetlands is home to 150 species of birds, 5 species of fish, 4 species of frog, yabbies, long necked tortoise and numerous aquatic invertebrate and fauna and was one of the first large constructed urban wetlands in Australia" (from [their website](#)). After a cuppa we all set out on a walk around the wetlands. Given a choice of a long walk and a shorter walk, we chose the longer one but it turned out to be shorter as we were back and waiting for those on the shorter walk.

Soon we were all back on the Salisbury Highway and heading for the new Northern Expressway via Port Wakefield Road. The new road is very smooth and certainly a lot quicker to travel on than Main North Road. As we approached Gawler we almost had a glider land on us as he made his approach to the aerodrome. I was sorry that I was not quick enough with my camera.

The Northern Expressway merges with the Gawler Bypass but at the Main North Road Overpass there is no mention of Gawler on the signs, so we continued onto the Sturt Highway and did a u-turn at the first available opportunity. We wandered our way around Gawler before arriving at Apex Park on Julian Whitelaw Place which was our lunch stop. It was very pleasant in the shade of the Moreton Bay Figs. It was good to see Tracy Neal's 1926 Dodge, newly restored by her late father Graham and Roger Keane.

After lunch and a chat we returned home via the Main North Road.

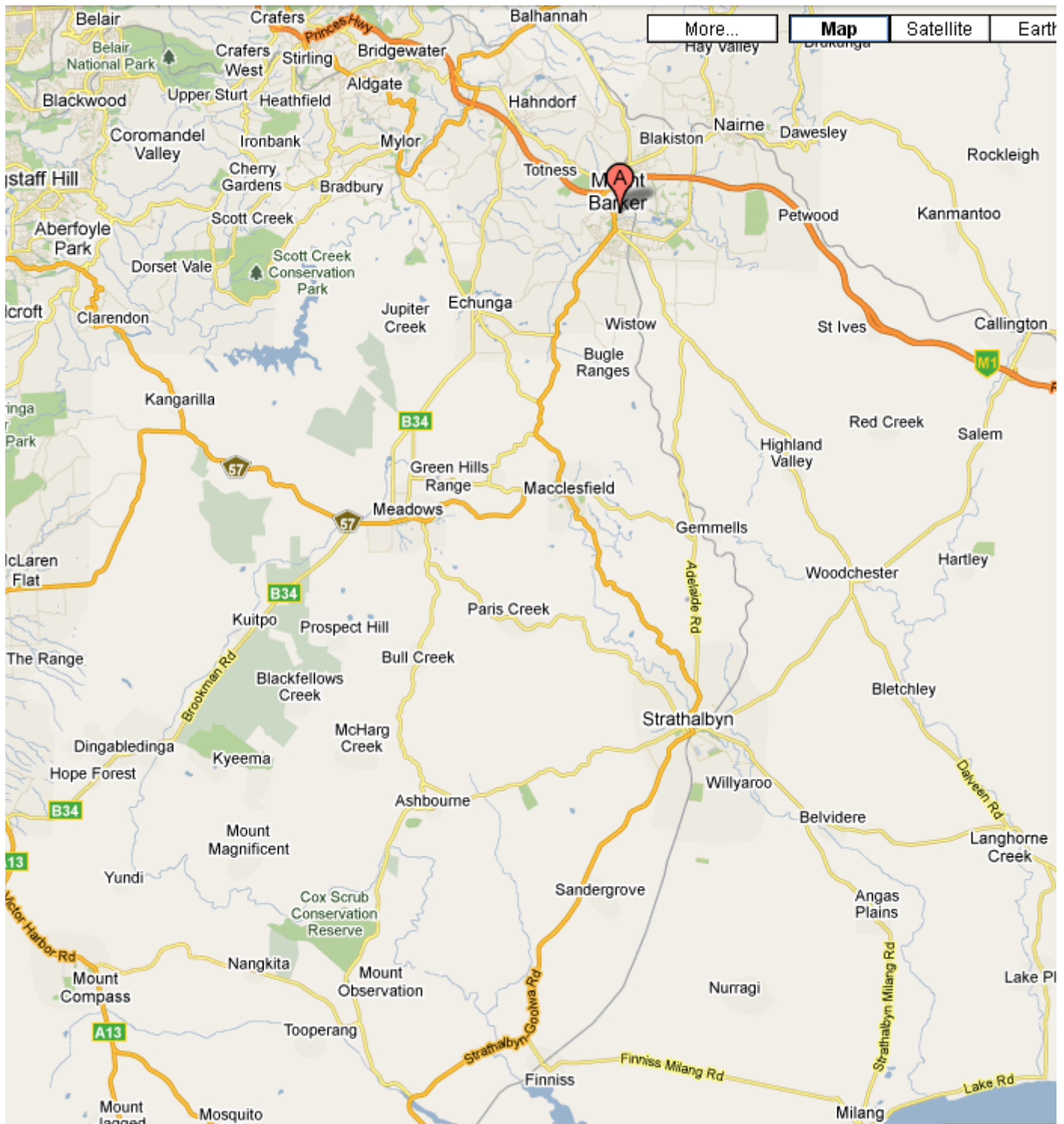
It was hard to imagine that an aircraft has so many gauges , and the steering wheel that steers the plane on the runway is only about 4 inches in diameter .
